

Section VI Use of Electronically Produced Ticket

Rule 48


The use and filing of a traffic ticket that is produced by computer or other electronic means is hereby authorized in the Clermont County Municipal Court pursuant to Traffic Rule 3(F). The electronically produced traffic ticket shall conform in all substantive respects to the Ohio Uniform Traffic Ticket. If an electronically produced ticket is issued at the scene of an alleged offense, the issuing officer shall provide the defendant with a paper copy of the ticket as required by division (E) of Traffic Rule 3. A copy of the ticket shall be filed by the charging agency with the Clermont County Municipal Clerk of Courts on paper, other than thermal paper, approved by said Clerk and sufficient to comply with the records retention requirements set forth in the Rules of Superintendence for the Courts of Ohio. The ticket may also be filed electronically with the Municipal Clerk of Courts in lieu of the paper filing.


